EASTER SUNDAY

Pope Leo XIV has called for **"Peace in the Middle East"**.

During the Holy Week preparations for the liturgies, Pope Leo XIV has issued a strong and direct appeal to world leaders—including U.S. President Donald Trump—calling for an end to the war in the Middle East. The Pope urged Christians to live Holy Week with an awareness of present suffering, reminding them that Christ's Passion continues in today's world. He called on all people "to live these days recognizing that **Christ is still crucified today**, that Christ still suffers today in the innocent, especially those who are suffering from violence, hatred, and war." Pope Leo also appealed to political leaders to pursue diplomacy and restraint, stressing that civilians—especially children and the most vulnerable—bear the greatest cost of modern conflicts.

Pope Leo XIV urged : "Let us pray for them, for the victims of war, let us pray that there may truly be a new, renewed peace, which can give new life to all," www.vaticannews.va/en/pope/news/2026-03

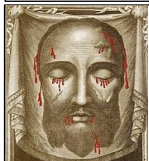
