Our Lady of Fatima Between May 13 and October 13, 1917, three Portuguese children–Francisco and Jacinta Marto and their cousin Lucia dos Santos–received apparitions of Our Lady at Cova da Iria near Fatima. Mary asked the children to pray the rosary for world peace, for the end of World War I, for sinners, and for the conversion of Russia. Mary gave the children three secrets. When Lucia grew up she became a Carmelite nun and died in 2005 at the age of 97.

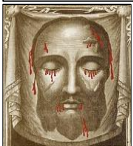
DUBLIN DIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE TO LOURDES 3rd to 8th September .
