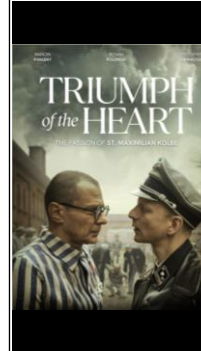

 homeland has face since the implementation of euthanasia.

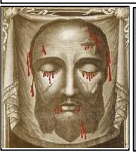


We were delighted to welcome members of the Bethlehem Curia and Veneranda

 renewal, Adoration in Church 2:30 until 3:30pm.
 The retreat aligns with the Legion motto **"Ad Jesum per Mariam"** (**"To Jesus
 through Mary"**) by helping members grow in Marian devotion and in the
 mission of bringing souls to Christ.
 Since its foundation in Dublin in 1921 by Frank Duff, the Legion of Mary's, lay
 members operate in local parish groups (*praesidia*), dedicating at least two
 hours a week in pairs to apostolic service, including street evangelization,
 visiting the sick and elderly, and running hostels for the homeless.
