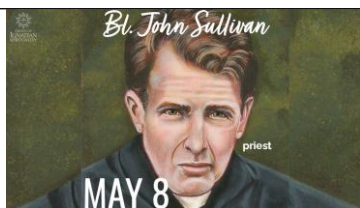

DUBLIN DIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE TO LOURDES 3rd to 8th September .

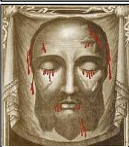
