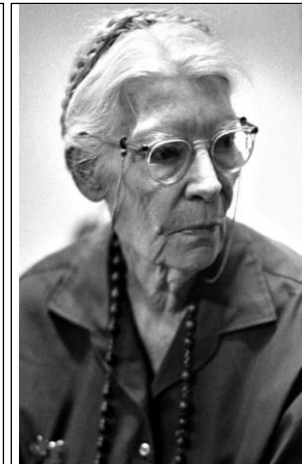

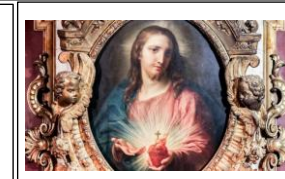

the poor. Come along to hear her remarkable story.



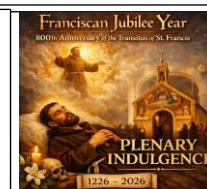

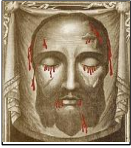
